




Day By Day

FOCUSING ON THE COURSE



The Christian life can be likened to a race with a finish line in eternity. Our goal is to stay on track and run with endurance, but we won't know the way forward unless we focus on Jesus. Because He ran the race perfectly, He can show us the way.

In the Christian life, we run the race of faith. We don't strive for the crown that only one can receive. We strive to finish strong in our faith. God makes us all winners when we cross the line. We get Him! Forever! Thus, we all win God by persevering in faith and getting to the finish line. But we, like runners, must lay aside hindrances of our endurance. Hebrews 12:1-2 says:

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross,

despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider him who endured from sinners such hostility against himself, so that you may not grow weary or fainthearted.

Runners not only properly nourish their body and recover well, but they also work hard to build endurance. They endure long runs. They do speed workouts. They lift weights. They stretch. They push through pain. They have sore muscles and tired lungs.

Likewise, as Christians, we work hard to strengthen our faith to endure the race of faith. We must seek Him daily in His word and in prayer. We must seek fellowship among other believers and let our fellow church members encourage us in the faith. We must welcome rebuke and embrace trials. Personal discipline is essential if we are to keep our eyes focused on Jesus.

Although sins are the most obvious threat, anything that takes precedence over our relationship with the Lord can send us down the wrong path. It's easy to let our families, jobs, and pleasures distract us from a wholehearted pursuit of Christ. Surprisingly, even God's blessings can hinder us if we start to prioritize them over the Lord.

For us as believers, the goal isn't to focus on the path or find our own way. We're to fix our eyes on Jesus—He's our guide and destination, and He will welcome us home when we cross the finish line into eternity.



They are surrounded by books of Jesus' teachings; trail markers noting attributes that guide our daily lives including joy, peace, love, and kindness; and a cross firmly fixed to solid rock.

LHM invites viewers to experience the hope and love found in Jesus, as well as join the Petal Pushers®, a volunteer group that decorates 8 to 10 Rose Parade floats annually.

- Expansion of the THRED.asia website to include culturally relevant content in multiple languages is reaching more people throughout Central Asia.


- Our Latin America Vivenciar.net platform will expand to reach the 40+ million Latinos in the United States.

TAKE A THAILAND TREK Without Leaving Your Home or School!

For 2021, *Gospel Adventures* is heading on a *Thailand Trek* with the country's national symbol, the elephant. Just like *Passport to Peru* and *Go Mongolia*, *Gospel Adventures: Thailand Trek* will be a free resource available to Christian schools, churches, homeschools, and individuals across the United States, filled with fun activities and an interactive website.

Gospel Adventures gives kids, and even some adults, an inside look into the day-to-day lives of people like them around the world through music, videos, and fun characters. Children can see, through the engaging videos, that there are children who share the same faith as them who are located all around the world.

Not only do participants get to see how people live and work in other countries, but they get to see God's work in action with examples of how they can share the Gospel with people in these areas through prayer and designated chapel offerings.

As a way to support children's ministry around the world, schools and churches can choose to collect donations through chapel offerings or change drives. These donations will go toward LHM's Global Kids Fund that supports ministries that are similar to the one they saw during the Gospel Adventures program.

Since 2012, these activities have led to more than \$200,000 being donated to LHM's Global

Kids Fund. Gifts given to the Global Kids Fund during *Thailand Trek* will go directly toward LHM's ministry work in Thailand. Every year for the holidays, including Christmas, National Children's Day, and Valentine's Day, **LHM-Thailand** conducts school outreach programs that reach between 3,000 and 5,000 children in schools throughout Thailand. During these events, LHM-Thailand staff shares the

Good News with students and teachers who have not yet heard the saving Gospel message. In addition, each student who attends the event receives a gift package filled with LHM children's bilingual booklets, a Bible story coloring book with a crayon or colored pencil, LHM mementos, and a sweet treat or cookie. A gift of \$5 will provide a special gift package to one child. Donations can be made online at lhm.org/give (and selecting Global Kids Fund from the dropdown menu) or mailed to the LHM office in St. Louis, MO.
