One day I took my children to the beach on a foggy morning. This was more than the usual Southern California June gloom, we could barely see anything in front of us! This reminds me of Philippians 3:13-14 (NIV) "Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. 

the Gathering Grounds. Portals of Prayer is great for personal devotions and can be used to open church meetings or Bible studies.







15th of this month! While you can apply for a six-month extension you are still required to pay any amount due in order to avoid the penalty and interest.

It is alarming to know that some folks among us either are unaware that they can get their taxes prepared for FREE, or that they may not qualify due to certain restrictions (they must not have been reading Day by Day articles on the subject)! Stop! No way are members and visitors unqualified to have their taxes prepared for FREE, and most restrictions that may be imposed by the general public are waived for YOU!

Although we have been blessed by getting most of our schedules filled up with clients, we will make every effort to accommodate you as a member or visitor of ASLC. Register by navigating to our website or pointing your smartphone camera to our QR code below, which will take you directly to the registration page.
