Trust In the Lord Stephanie Harmon

Several months ago, I was invited by a friend to attend a speaking event led by Megan Fate Marshman on her book titled "Relaxed - Walking with the One Who Is Not Worried about a Thing". The title of the book alone caused a stirring in my mind and heart. Relaxed. When was the last time I felt "relaxed"? What does it look like to be relaxed? I certainly do not feel relaxed most days. Between the constant distractions, hurried schedules, and a never-ending todo list, life does not feel relaxed. Does the word relaxed describe you?

Megan Fate Marshman explains further that many of us Christians feel this burnout because we are attempting to figure life out all on our own. We might try to pray more, sin less, love more, but on our own, this is all impossible. While our cultural norm tells us to be independent and self-reliant, we need complete dependence on Christ. Jesus even tells us in John 15:5, "...apart from me you can do nothing." Apart from our Savior, we

struggle every day. Thankfully, we don't have to live this way!

Trusting in the Lord isn't just a one-time event; He wants to be part of every step of our daily journey. He desires to walk alongside us each day, sharing in our joys and challenges. When we lean on Jesus and submit to Him, we can relax in the assurance that we are taken care of. Megan Fate Marshman gave a powerful visual for trusting in the Lord - think of whatever is giving you anxiety and place it in your hand and close it. Can you open your hand to God and offer Him this burden? I struggle in this area, maybe you do too. But perhaps this is a key to seeing where God wants us to grow and where we need to trust in Him more. We don't have to hold onto our anxiety alone; we can open these worries up to Jesus. And He loves us the way we are.

In the end, we can relax with confidence knowing that Jesus will guide us every step of the way. The best part? We're never on this journey alone!




Join Us for Pickleball

Large Print Ministry Jim Ryan

The Large Print Ministry is an off shoot of the Braille Ministry that was begun in the Narthex of the old Sanctuary in 1980. We operate under the direction of Lutheran Braille Workers Inc. located in Yucaipa, CA. Currently we are producing six different publications including complete bibles, which are printed in 26 volumes and shipped in three boxes. The New Testaments are printed in 9 volumes and shipped in one box. Then there is the Today's Light monthly devotion. The production of the number of this devotional varies each month but is usually around 200 copies which are shipped out in special envelopes. The other devotional we print is called Mustard Seed and there are usually five copies that are mailed out.

We also have a "Prison Ministry" that we are responsible for, and these publications have a special cloth binding which is applied by a heat process. Currently we print a complete bible in 7 volumes, and they are shipped in two boxes. The other is the Lutheran Service Book which is printed in three volumes and shipped in one box.

These publications are shipped domestically and internationally. Fun Fact! All our publications are shipped as FREE MATTER for the handicapped. Thanks to an agreement with the

U.S. Post Office. There are, however, operating expenses, such as paper, we use 20# and 60# paper depending on the publication and where it goes. Then there are two different size cartons, packing materials, different kinds of packing tape, 5 different sizes of binding

combs, hole punching machines, and different machines to do the binding.

We have small groups of volunteers that meet, on campus, in a space generously provided by Abiding Savior, three to four days a week for about three hours in the mornings. These volunteers use two high speed printers, printing nearly 100,000 pages a month, punch holes for the bindings, bind, and ship an assigned monthly quota for each publication.

The work is easy, the comradery is uplifting and knowing that your efforts provide spiritual comfort to those who have trouble seeing. VITA: Appreciation Ceremony

You are all invited and encouraged to take a look at our VITA Team's poster mounted in the

corner of the Adult Education Room. This poster was presented to the team at a recent ceremony recognizing all of the VITA sites in the greater South Orange County area that operate through United Way of South Orange County.

The poster shows the statistics of the metrics achieved for the 2024 tax season, which took place this year. Adjacent to the poster is the one received in 2024 for the 2023 tax season (sort of a mini art gallery!)

You will see by comparing the posters that we exceeded the stats from the prior season. Although we did not receive an award this year, our neighboring VITA sites were awarded various trophies. Laguna Woods Village (which has a very large "built-in" clientele and very numerous volunteers) was a repeat in receiving awards, and St. Killian's—also with a large team of volunteers—received an award.

The Abiding Savior Lutheran Church VITA Team does not take a vacation; some of the team members provide tax preparation assistance to San Francisco Solano Catholic Church in Rancho Santa Margarita. They are one of only a couple of South Orange County VITA sites that offer free income tax preparation.

May our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ continue to bless the VITA Team in serving our communities with financial support and being a witness and example of your love for them.


