REGISTRATION & SUPPLY FEE

- **NON-REFUNDABLE. NON-TRANSFERABLE FEES.**
- Fees support fixed costs including instructional materials, textbooks, student supplies, workbooks, emergency supplies, student insurance, Field Day, Spirit T-shirt, Art Masters, Grades 5–8 locker fees, and the school yearbook.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Tuition is an annual charge and may be paid through monthly installments.

- **Option A:** 12-month payment plan, first payment due June 2026 and monthly through May 2027.
- **Option B:** 10-month payment plan, first payment due June 2026. Remaining payments from September 2026 through May 2027.

GRANTS AND DISCOUNTS

- Grants and discounts are available for families, including for LCMS Full-Time Workers.
- Families are eligible for one (1) tuition discount or grant per family from the following options:
 - Active Member Church Grant (application required)
 - Multi-Student Discount
 - LCMS Full-Time Worker Grant (application required)

FACTS | TUITION PAYMENT

- All tuition payments are processed through **FACTS Tuition Management**.
- Automatic deductions may be made from a checking account, savings account, debit card, or credit card. Credit card payments are subject to a convenience fee.
- Incidental charges (extended care and other fees) are billed through FACTS Incidental billing by the 10th of the following month.
- Monthly tuition payments are due by the 20th of the month.
- Late or dishonored payments will incur fees (see Parent–Student Handbook).

Additional FACTS Policies:

- Students enrolling after September 16, 2026 will have tuition pro-rated based on enrollment days, divided into equal monthly payments.
- Final tuition payments for all students must be paid by May 20, 2027.
- Extended care incidental charges incurred after that date must be paid by June 20, 2027.
- Families must review and establish their FACTS tuition plan annually.
- Divorced or separated parents must share one FACTS account and notify the school in writing of any changes. Financial disputes are the responsibility of the parents.

MID-YEAR ENROLLMENT

- For students enrolling after the first day of school, tuition will be pro-rated based on remaining school days. Registration or supply fees are not adjusted.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

- Parents must notify the Principal in writing to terminate enrollment. Upon withdrawal, all accounts must be settled, including tuition for the month of withdrawal.
- **Financial policies:**
 - ✓ Refund Policy - There are no refunds on previously paid tuition installments, including payments made from June through August. If the full year was paid in advance, only the remaining equivalent installments are refundable.
 - ✓ Withdrawals made before the first day of school will result in non-refundable payments for June through August.
 - ✓ Refund Deadline— No refunds will be issued after March 1st of the current school year.
 - ✓ Account Clearance— Report Cards and school records will not be released until all accounts are current.
 - ✓ FACTS Account Inactivation— A student's FACTS account will be deactivated 30 days after the written notice of withdrawal.
